Creating a Proper Application Form

Your project will have a much better chance of being accepted into the D2I Program if it has the following:

- Aligns with D2I's vision and objectives.
- Includes growth-oriented milestones and KPIs.
- Indicates a mainnet launch timeline, ideally by the end of April, if not already live.
- Highlights your project's unique features and competitive advantages.
- Demonstrates potential for significant growth in line with D2I's vision.
- For projects already deployed, show a track record of success.
- Maintain a public profile that reflects your project's development stage.
- Adheres to open-source requirements; closed-source projects are not eligible

Your Application

- Maintain professionalism in your writing. While perfection is not expected, attention to spelling, grammar, and clear, direct responses will improve your application's impact.
- Ensure clarity and detail in your application, adhering to the [D2I Milestones Guideline](#).
- Provide thorough answers, supported by external links if necessary (e.g., websites, articles, social media) where relevant.

Note

- The suggestions offered here are intended to guide, not mandate. For aspects not specified in the guidelines, feel free to compose them at your project's discretion.
- Lacking certain requested details in the application form, due to their irrelevance or absence of experience in specific areas, does not automatically disqualify a project from the D2I Program.
